





HOW TO:

Get Started with Mango Languages


These instructions guide you through the steps needed to register for and use **Mango Languages**. Mango Languages is an online language-learning platform that features more than 70 world languages and dialects, with courses crafted using conversational methodology. Every self-paced course includes cultural insights and grammatical nuances, delivered through native-speaker dialogue.

Create a Mango Languages account.


1. From the Deschutes Public Library home page, click “Research & Learning” to view the drop-down list; select “DIY / Self-Improvement”
2. Scroll to the bottom of the page and select “Mango Languages”
3. You can also go directly to the Mango Languages login page by [clicking on this link](#).
4. You will be prompted to Log In. Since you don’t have an account yet, click on the Sign Up button at the bottom of the page. Walk through the steps to create your profile, entering your email address and setting a password. Then, click “Sign Up.”




5. Once you’ve created your profile, you will be prompted to subscribe. Your subscription is FREE with your library card, so grab you library card number and click on “Find Mango.”
6. You’ll be taken to a dialog box to “Unlock Access to Mango.” As you type in your ZIP code, library names will appear below. Click on Deschutes Public Library District.



7. When prompted, type in your library card number and click “Connect.” Your profile is now linked to Deschutes Public Library’s subscription. Click “Start Using Mango.”



8. Start learning! There is so much to do in Mango. Each unit has several Chapters and each Chapter has several Lessons. Start at the beginning or take a Placement quiz. Click on Support for more detailed answers to your questions.
